Temporary sign permit required.	One temporary sign or banner is allowed per business suite or space per street frontage.	The total aggregate area of a temporary sign or banner shall not exceed 10% of the area of the storefront to which such temporary sign or banner is attached, or 100 square feet, whichever is less.	<p>Temporary signs or banners shall only be attached to an exterior wall of the building.</p> <p>Temporary signs or banners shall not be hung from awnings or other structures extending from a building.</p>	<p>A business is permitted to display a temporary sign or banner for 3 separate 30-day periods for a total of 90 days during a one-year period of time.</p> <p>The one-year period of time starts from the date a temporary sign permit is issued to a business.</p>
