Policy No. 245

PURPOSE: To establish a policy regarding the stockpile of materials in the Public Right of Way.

POLICY: No construction or other materials shall be placed in the Public Right of Way without first obtaining an encroachment permit from the City of Highland Engineering Department.

The City Fire Marshal shall first be provided information regarding the type of material, volume and location of any stockpile in the ROW. The Fire Marshal may require additional information and will ascertain the need for a fire or stockpile permit.

No gunite operations shall be performed in the Right of Way without first obtaining an encroachment permit.

No construction materials can be situated or allowed to flow into the Public Right of Way storm gutters or drains. All applicable BMP's shall be in place at all times on stockpiles to prevent run-off of materials.

No lane closures are to be performed without an engineering encroachment permit and traffic control plan.

ANALYSIS: Construction equipment located in the Right of Way, materials dropped or allowed to remain in the Public Right of Way may create a hazardous situation and public liability.
