

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Highland will conduct a public hearing per Elections Code Section 21607.1 on August 24, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., at Highland City Hall in the City Council Chambers located at 27215 Base Line, Highland, CA 92346, at which the City Council will:

- 1) Receive a report on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw City Council election district boundaries; and
- 2) Receive public input regarding the potential composition of City Council district boundaries.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic public health orders, the public hearing will be held either in the City Hall Donahue Council Chambers, 27215 Base Line, Highland, California, 92346, or in another manner specified in the meeting agenda. Please check the August 24, 2021 City Council agenda once it is posted on the City's website for information as to how to participate in the City Council meeting.

For those wishing to make public comments at the August 24, 2021 City Council meeting, please submit your comments via email to be read aloud at the meeting. Comments can be submitted any time prior to the meeting as well as during the meeting up until the end of the corresponding item. Please submit your comments to the City Clerk at publiccomment@cityofhighland.org. All email comments shall be subject to the same rules as would otherwise govern speaker comments at the City Council meeting. If the public hearing is held in person at the City Council chambers, in person comments will also be permitted.

All staff reports and supporting documentation will be available for review in the office of the City Clerk at 27215 Base Line, Highland, CA 92346, and on the City's website at www.cityofhighland.org/redistricting on and after August 19, 2021.

Please contact the City Clerk's office at 909.864.6861, ext. 226, if live translation in an applicable language (Spanish), as determined by the Secretary of State, is needed for this hearing. Notification 72 hours prior to the meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements.

If any matter proposed herein is challenged in court, there may be a limitation to raising only those issues at the public hearing described herein, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Highland at, or prior to, the public hearing.
