NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Highland will conduct a public hearing per Elections Code Section 21607.1 on January 11, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., at Highland City Hall in the City Council Chambers located at 27215 Base Line, Highland, CA 92346, at which the City Council will:

- 1) Receive public input regarding the potential composition of City Council district boundaries;
and
- 2) Review draft maps.

All interested persons are invited to attend said hearing and express opinions and comments relating to this matter. This is the third of the four scheduled public hearings. For those wishing to make public comments at the January 11, 2022 City Council meeting, please submit your comments via email to be read aloud at the meeting. Comments can be submitted any time prior to the meeting as well as during the meeting up until the end of the corresponding item. Please submit your comments to the City Clerk at publiccomment@cityofhighland.org. All email comments shall be subject to the same rules as would otherwise govern speaker comments at the City Council meeting. Members of the public will be permitted to make public comments in person.

All staff reports and supporting documentation will be available for review in the office of the City Clerk at 27215 Base Line, Highland, CA 92346, and on the City's website at www.cityofhighland.org/redistricting on and after January 6, 2022.

Please contact the City Clerk's office at 909.864.6861, ext. 226, if live translation in an applicable language (Spanish), as determined by the Secretary of State, is needed for this hearing or if a reasonable accommodation in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act is needed. Notification 72 hours prior to the meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements.

If any matter proposed herein is challenged in court, there may be a limitation to raising only those issues at the public hearing described herein, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Highland at, or prior to, the public hearing.
