



NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF NOMINATION PERIOD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nomination Period for non-incumbent candidates for Member of the City Council for City Council District 1 for the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, has been extended five (5) days pursuant to Elections Code §10225.

The filing period was extended beyond the initial August 9, 2024 deadline because District 1 Incumbent City Councilmember Jesus “Jesse” Chavez-Cordova did not file nomination papers. The filing period for incumbents is now closed.

Interested residents for Member of the City Council for City Council District 1 must file nomination papers by the new deadline: **August 14, 2024, by appointment only, during normal business hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Eligibility to run for City Council is as follows:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be 18 years of age or older on or before election day
- Reside in, and be a registered voter in, the district in which he or she seeks election at the time nomination papers are issued
- Reside in the district during their incumbency
